Gessoed Brown Paper Technique

**Paints:**

Grumbacher Academy Brand 7.5 ml tubes

1. GRA 001 Alizarin Crimson
2. GRA 027 Cadmium Red Light
3. GRA 031 Cadmium Yellow Deep
4. GRA 036 Cadmium Yellow Pale
5. GRA 162 Permanent Green Light
6. GRA 106 Hookers Green Deep
7. GRA 205 Thalo Green
8. GRA 206 Thalo Blue
9. GRA 049 Cobalt Blue

Cotman Brand

10. C231 Dioxazine Violet
11. C398 Mauve

**Palette** – enamel tray

**Sketch Pad** – 5 1/2 inch by 8 1/2 inch or compara

**Spray Bottle** – Windex spray top preferred

**Paper**

Mat board - 32 x 40 inches cut into three pieces (2 pieces 16 x 20 and 1 piece (20 x 32 or any size you choose). Buy an inexpensive mat board since the brown wrapping paper will be glued to it. Cheap Joes has a Bainbridge board (BA203) cream, smooth or any color at \$6.19 minimum order is 12 boards. Perhaps you can share an order.

Brown wrapping paper – medium to heavy shipping weight. Buy enough to cover the three pieces of mat board with some to spare for borders. This will be done in class.

**Brushes** – medium to large rounds. I use Cheap Joes Golden Fleece rounds, #12, 28 and 32. Flat brushes for big washes and for gluing – 2 inch or 3 inch.

**Elmer's glue** – pour into container with lid and an opening approximately 3 inches – don't dilute.

**Gesso** – pint

**Miscellaneous**

Charcoal – soft, medium size, round sticks (Cheap Joes has a charcoal holder that's a great tool.)

Cutting knife – Stanley cutter or Xacto knife

Chamois – natural (best purchased at auto supply store. Suggestion: cut into smaller pieces to sell in class  
½ roll of toilet tissue (medium weight)

Plastic wrap

Paper towel and newspaper

Pencils

White shower curtain - Dollar store kind

Reference material – your own photos & sketches, magazine pics for ideas, color, and inspiration. Almost any subject will work: florals, figures, still life, land or seascape, fantasy.
