Our painting will include acrylic paint and many or just a few dimensional elements.

**Rugged:** wandet the hardware store—nuts, keys, rope (frayed) burlap, twigs flat stones bark oyster shells....

**Genteel.** Wander Joann's Fabric Michael's satin and lace, ribbons, buttons, beads, rhinestones, flat marbles pressed flowers...

We will consider elements of design such as variety, repetition, rhythms etc. The strength of the composition will elevate your unique work from fine art.

Remember to use your Joann's and Michael's Coupons!

**PAINT**

Any acrylic based paint. Bring a few small, lidded containers (KFC sides are ideal size or look at the \$ store.

**Brushes**

Acrylic or watercolor medium to large.

**GROUND**

Canvas pre-stretched (shallow or deep) 2- 24"x30" or larger or with a grouping of smaller ones.

**ADHESIVES**

Elmers for light elements/modeling gel for heavier. Modeling paste for surface textures.

\*I will have rice papers and tubes of acrylic paint, Elmer's Glue modeling gel and paste at the workshop. Cost for using these items will be decided at the end of the workshop on an individual basis.
